

## TONY DANZA RETURNS TO CAFÉ CARLYLE, MARCH 26-30



Back by popular demand, the iconic **Tony Danza** and his four-piece band return to **Café Carlyle** with their hit cabaret show, *Tony Danza: Standards & Stories*, **March 26-30**. Combining timeless music with wit, charm, storytelling, and a dash of soft shoe and ukulele, Danza performs a selection of his favorite standards from the Great American Songbook while interweaving stories about his life and personal connection to the music. The show has entertained audiences around the country with *The New York Times* raving about his Café Carlyle debut: “Tony’s a live wire who tap-dances, plays the ukulele, tells stories and radiates irresistible charm” and in a separate review, “he exudes the kind of charisma that can’t be taught!”

Perhaps best known for his starring roles on two of television's most cherished and long-running series, *Taxi* and *Who's the Boss?*, Tony Danza has also established himself as a song and dance man, and recently received rave reviews for his performance in the Broadway musical comedy, *Honeymoon in Vegas*, with *The*

*New York Times* calling his performance “sly genius,” and a “career high.” Among his past successes, Tony has starred on Broadway in *The Producers* and *A View from the Bridge*, *The Iceman Cometh* and starred in beloved films such as *Angels in the Outfield*, *She’s Out of Control*, and *The Hollywood Knights*.

Danza most recently starred in *The Good Cop*, a Netflix original series, now streaming, from the creator of *Monk*. In the series, Danza plays a street smart, rule-breaking, ex-NYC cop and father to a straight-laced rule-following cop, played by Josh Groban.

Café Carlyle is known for talents including Woody Allen, who regularly appears on Monday evenings to play with the Eddy Davis New Orleans jazz band. For three decades, Café Carlyle was synonymous with the legendary Bobby Short, who thrilled sell-out crowds for 36 years. His spirit lives on through the music at Café Carlyle.

Continuing the tradition of the 1930s supper club, Café Carlyle features original murals created by French artist Marcel Vertès, the Oscar-winning art director of the 1952 *Moulin Rouge*.
